

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

PHS is offering a safe and healthy Show experience for all attendees, which includes limited attendance, masks, cleaning protocols, and enforcement of health and safety regulations.

## SHOW ACCESSIBILITY

The Flower Show at FDR Park is an outdoor experience and is accessible to visitors with disabilities. The Show grounds consist of varied terrain, but strollers and wheelchairs can be utilized on both paved and gravel paths. Guests are encouraged to bring their own wheelchair or motorized scooter; however, both will be available for rent at the Show. Please know that there can be guests, bright colors, and loud sounds throughout the Show grounds. If this is a consideration, plan your visit during the week in the late afternoon or evening.

## GETTING TO THE SHOW

### Coming by Car

From Center City: Take Broad Street South to Pattison Avenue. Utilize parking lots at Wells Fargo Center or Citizens Bank Park.

From I-95 North or South: Take the Broad Street/Pattison Avenue Exit of I-95. If coming from I-95 Southbound, turn right onto Broad Street. If coming from I-95 Northbound, the exit puts you on Broad Street. Continue straight on Broad Street. At the third traffic light, which is Pattison Avenue, utilize parking lots at Wells Fargo Center or Citizens Bank Park.

From Rte. 76 going East (Schuylkill Expressway): Get off at the Penrose Avenue/International Airport Exit (left lane exit). Go to the end of the exit road. At the traffic light, turn left onto Penrose. At the first stoplight, turn right onto Pattison Avenue. Utilize parking lots at Wells Fargo Center or Citizens Bank Park.

From Rte. 76 going West and the Walt Whitman Bridge: Take Exit 350 to 7th Street. Follow 7th to Pattison Avenue. Turn right on Pattison and utilize parking lots at Wells Fargo Center or Citizens Bank Park.

### SEPTA

The Flower Show is easily reached by the Broad Street Subway, with a five-block walk from the NRG/Pattison Ave Station. The #17 bus heading to the Naval Base stops one block from the Show at 20th Street and Pattison Avenue. Visit SEPTA.org to obtain route and schedule information.



"HABITAT: Nature's Masterpiece" will explore the beauty of life through nature's kaleidoscopic lens. Exhibits and attractions are spread through three separate areas:

### PLANT DISTRICT

The PLANT DISTRICT features a variety of plants that have been carefully arranged in the Show's long-standing PHS Hamilton Horticult, showcasing hundreds of plants in their purest form by gardeners who have spent months priming their flora for just this event! Plant 'galleries' will allow guests to browse their favorites or explore new floral and plant varieties. Plant owners will be available to discuss their expertise in gardening.

Gardeners will learn about the planting, growing, care and maintenance of plants from PHS experts and other plant-knowledgeable volunteers.

### GARDEN DISTRICT

See the 'how to' of gardening in the GARDEN DISTRICT—with practical garden techniques, ongoing learning, and interaction with experts, gardeners at all levels will find something to enjoy! The Garden District will feature a number of unique experiences, such as Butterflies Live!, the PHS Gardeners Grove, and more.

Within the Grove, Gardeners will want to visit the PHS Gardeners Green, the educational section of the Flower Show where PHS experts and other gardening experts will safely hold informative sessions on a variety of topics in horticulture. A curated library for gardeners will be onsite in the PHS Members' Lounge, as well as a shady outdoor area and café to reflect on your new plant knowledge. The PHS Shop is also featured within the Gardeners Grove, offering Show-special merchandise to celebrate this year's theme and other unique gardening items for those who love the outdoors.

### DESIGN DISTRICT

As the largest district at the Show, the DESIGN DISTRICT has been curated for the garden enthusiast who wants to see all the horticultural pomp and circumstance that the Flower Show has represented for decades! The area features the largest displays of floral and landscape design.

Award-winning designers from all over the globe exhibit at the Flower Show, bringing the most current trends in landscape design, outdoor floral design, art combined with nature, and sustainability to guests. Guests can talk with the designers, view 360° displays on the grand lawn of FDR Park, take photos outdoors with the displays, and take in the beauty, creativity, and artistry of each exhibit.
