Supplies to Have for This Week

- O Pencil with eraser
- Sheets of plain white paper (*Computer* paper, sketchbook paper, blank backside of a flyer, etc.)
- O Writing paper
- O Colorful construction paper
- O Old magazine or newspaper pages
- O Scissors
- O Glue stick
- Tape (Clear scotch, masking, etc.)
- Drawing / coloring supplies (Markers, crayons, colored pencils, etc.)
- Pipe cleaners or easily bendable wire precut into multiple 12" pieces

- Thin, easy-to-cut cardboard (such as empty cereal or cracker boxes) / Cardstock
- O Brads/brass fasteners
- String/yarn/ribbon/twine, assorted colors/textures
- O Popsicle sticks/wooden skewers/straws
- Brown paper lunch bag or paper shopping bag
- Print out <u>Zoo Animal Cam Bingo Sheets</u> (or make some by hand!)
- Miscellaneous collage or 3D items (See Crafty Creative Reusables list for ideas)
- Optional: dry pastels/oil pastels/sidewalk
