#### Additional Required Materials:

- Self-healing mat
- mat knife (with new blade)
- Scissors
- 12" ruler
- Pencil
- bone folder
- white glue
- glue stick
- double sided tape
- Scrap paper
- Acrylic medium/ Yes Paste®
- Geli® plate, 5" x 5" or larger
- Brayer- 4" or 6"
- Stamp Pads (not dye based) preferably a black, a metallic and another color
- Paper for printing, for example: printer paper, light sketch paper, deli paper, cardstock
- Acrylic paint, any kind. What you have, or choose a blue, red, yellow, black, white, and a metallic paint.
- Mark Making/Texture Making Tools, for example: chopsticks, plastic combs, craft paint spreaders with notches, disposable forks, old credit cards, foam packing cut into shapes, wine corks, carved erasers, food (for printing, think cut apples or potatoes, etc,) cheesecloth, produce bags, bubble wrap, Store bought stencils and stamps.
