

Bead Weaving: On and Off the Loom Instructor: Mïa Vollkommer

Although all these links are to Beadaholique, I have no affiliation with this company (I would trust them as a vendor however). The links are meant to illustrate items that may be unfamiliar to you. I always recommend that you take this list to your local bead shop if you have one. Not only are you supporting a small business, but the staff there can help you find exactly what you need.

Tools and Supplies needed for the class:

Tools:

- **Bead weaving loom** there are lots of looms out there at a lot of different prices. Even a simple/inexpensive loom can make beautiful projects. Please purchase something similar to this style loom (also available at Michael's)

- English Bead weaving needles (size 12)

- Sharp scissors
- A ruler
- 1 roll of 1" blue painter's tape
- Really good lighting
- · Reading glasses, a magnifier visor or other magnifying aid
- bead pad (optional but highly recommended)

Findings:

In the case of bead weaving, "findings" would be the clasps that finish your project. There are MANY different ways to finish bead weaving, both with and without metal clasps. I include this link to show

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you one example of a metal clasp, but I would recommend holding off on purchasing one until after class. I'll show you how to finish a piece with a beaded clasp, so you may not need a metal one at all.

Beads & String:

There are many kinds of seed bead shapes and sizes. In this class we will be using either **Delicas** or **Japanese Round** seed beads in **Size 11/0** (Czech seed beads will work too but are a bit more finicky). I recommend having **7-10g of 5 different colors**.

For the stringing material I recommend Fireline, but you can use a Nymo Cotton thread as well

- Fireline 4lb test (smoke or crystal):

- **Beeswax** the Nymo in the link above is pre-waxed. If you purchase an unwaxed thread I'd recommend also purchasing beeswax, which helps keep the thread from tangling.
