## Log Cabin Building Blocks

Supply list:

- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter \& extra blades
- Cutting mat
- Acrylic ruler 18 or $24^{\prime \prime}$ long
- Acrylic square for rotary cutter, 9 " or larger
- Scissors for threads
- Pins
- Thread - Good quality thread in a medium value like gray, taupe, lavender.
- Batting - Quilter's Dream request or Dream green, or your choice SIZE FOR YOUR PROJECT.

Fabrics - prewashed
Please have an assortment of cut strips in any width, any print from your scrap collection. Strips should be longer than 18". Even ugly or mis-cut pieces from another project will do.

## BEFORE CLASS:

- Cut the center fabric into 2" strips.
- Cut one strip of each additional fabric in your choice of $1.5^{\prime \prime}, 2^{\prime \prime}$, or $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ widths.

FOR A Table runner materials
Backing - 1 yard for back of table runner
Centers - a 2" strip cut into at least $10-2$ " squares
"Logs" -Up to 1 yard total of assorted strips of quilting fabric:
$1 / 2$ yard total of light value
$1 / 8$ yard total of medium value
$1 / 2$ yard total of dark value

FOR A Throw quilt $60 \times 60$ "
Backing -3 yards for a $60 \times 60$ " throw

Centers $-1 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$. medium value for the center.
Up to 3 yards total of quilting fabric in the following pieces:
1 yard total of light value in $1 / 8$ to $1 / 4$ yard pieces
1 yard total of medium value in $1 / 8$ to $1 / 4$ yard pieces
1 yard total of dark value in $1 / 8$ to $1 / 4$ yard pieces
