A blend of Viognier, Roussanne, and Chardonnay from Tabor's Shifon Vineyard in the Golan Heights.

The Wine is complex and multilayered with aromatic fruit, full body and long finish.

2018 Harvest

The season started early following warm and dry winter.

Gladly, June, July and August were convenient with warm days and Pleasant nights throughout the country. These ideal conditions, together with special care of Tabor growers contributed to a slow, balanced ripening.

Growing Regions

All three varieties planted in the Shifon Vineyard, 1000 Meters above sea level. The cool weather brings a long, balanced ripening and together with the Golan Heights volcanic soil we get rich and complex wines.

OVERVIEW: One of the first wines made by Casa Ferreirinha following Barca-Velha – first vintage was 1960 – and still a reference for the Douro region.

VARIETIES: 42% Touriga Franca, 30% Touriga Nacional, 22% Tinta Roriz, 6% Tinta Barroca

WINEMAKING: Vinified at the wineries of Quinta do Seixo, in Cima Corgo, and Quinta da Leda, in the Douro Superior with grapes sourced from these two sub-regions. After soft-crushing and destemming, the grapes are transferred to stainless steel tanks, where alcoholic fermentation occurs for an average of 8 days. During this phase, soft maceration at controlled temperatures takes place for delicate extraction of color and aromas.

AGING: The wine is aged in neutral French oak barrels (2nd – 4th use) for 12 months.

TASTING NOTES: Notes of red and black fruit with hints of cocoa and chocolate. There are further spicy notes and a well-integrated oak element adding complexity. It has powerful and firm tannins, a balanced acidity and a smooth finish.

ENJOY: An excellent option to accompany meat, cheeses and pasta dishes. It may also be enjoyed with white meat or oven-steamed fish.

95% Grenache, 4% Mourvedre, 1% Syrah

Vineyard - Dead Poplar Vineyard, Yakima Valley AVA

Production/Aging - 60% Whole clusters native fermented in wood upright and stainless steel. 35 day maceration and aged in neutral puncheons sur lie for 22 months.

Notes - Our Dead Poplar Estate vineyard is on a mixture of sandy soils that scream aromatics. A combination of organic and regenerative farming is used in the vineyard. Natural garrigue is allowed to blossom in the vineyard creating beautiful smells and homes for beneficial insects. If you can be patient the wine will open up over the course of a few hours and show you a beautiful delicate side that is rare in Grenache. We recommend 3-4 hours in the decanted and a temperature of 60-65 degrees in the glass.

Tasting Note

The Merlot reveals a dark ruby color/aromas of plum, prominent toasted oak/spice. Aged for 8 months in French oak, it is ripe/full in the mouth with a soft texture, ripe tannins/a long finish.

the regions

The North Coast AVA spans six winegrowing counties—including Sonoma, Napa and Mendocino—all influenced to a degree by the Pacific Ocean and offering a wide range of microclimates. For this release, the Cabernet Sauvignon was grown in Mendocino, an area that is divided into 6 smaller sub regions.

winemaker notes

“Mendocino fruit provides the backbone for this expressive Cabernet Sauvignon. To fully extract color and tannins, the juice was left in contact with the skins for an extended maceration period, drawing layers of aroma and flavors from the fruit while giving this wine its elegant depth and body across the palate.”

- Persistent dark fruit, predominant black cherry and blackberry
- Undertones of brown sugar, coffee, cedar and a hint of tobacco

- Expressive black cherry, blackberry, plum, blueberry and licorice
- Firm tannin entry opens to a broad mid-palate

- This versatile Cabernet Sauvignon is at home with classic pastry-wrapped Beef Wellington, or a piled-high tri-tip sandwich on grilled sourdough.

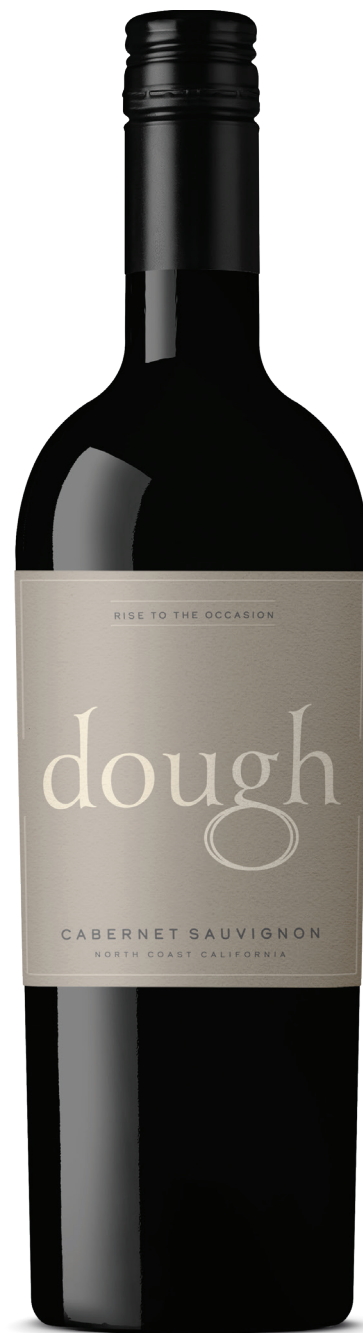
technical information

The wine was stainless steel fermented on skins, with daily maceration to extract color and tannin. It underwent 100% malolactic fermentation, and exhibits gentle oak influence.

SAGE RIDGE VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON

2019

Hand harvested at night. Hand sorted and gently processed to ensure whole berries are fed into closed top tanks. 5 to 7 days cold soak followed by native yeast fermentation. Bottled unfined and unfiltered.

VINTAGE NOTES

2019 is the hallmark vintage for the last decade. Early spring was cool and wet. These conditions pushed budbreak a week later than average.

Temperatures were mild, creating a textbook environment for bloom and berry set. This trend continued through veraison in July. "Let 'em hang a little longer" was the call at the end of most scouting days as cool temperatures slowed the pace and optimized phenolic ripening at lower Brix.

TASTING NOTES

Dark garnet in color with blue undertones. Aromas of dark cherry and dried flowers. Fine grained tannins frame a rich and dense palate with great acidity.

A delicious juciness on the palate gives way to a lingering finish.
