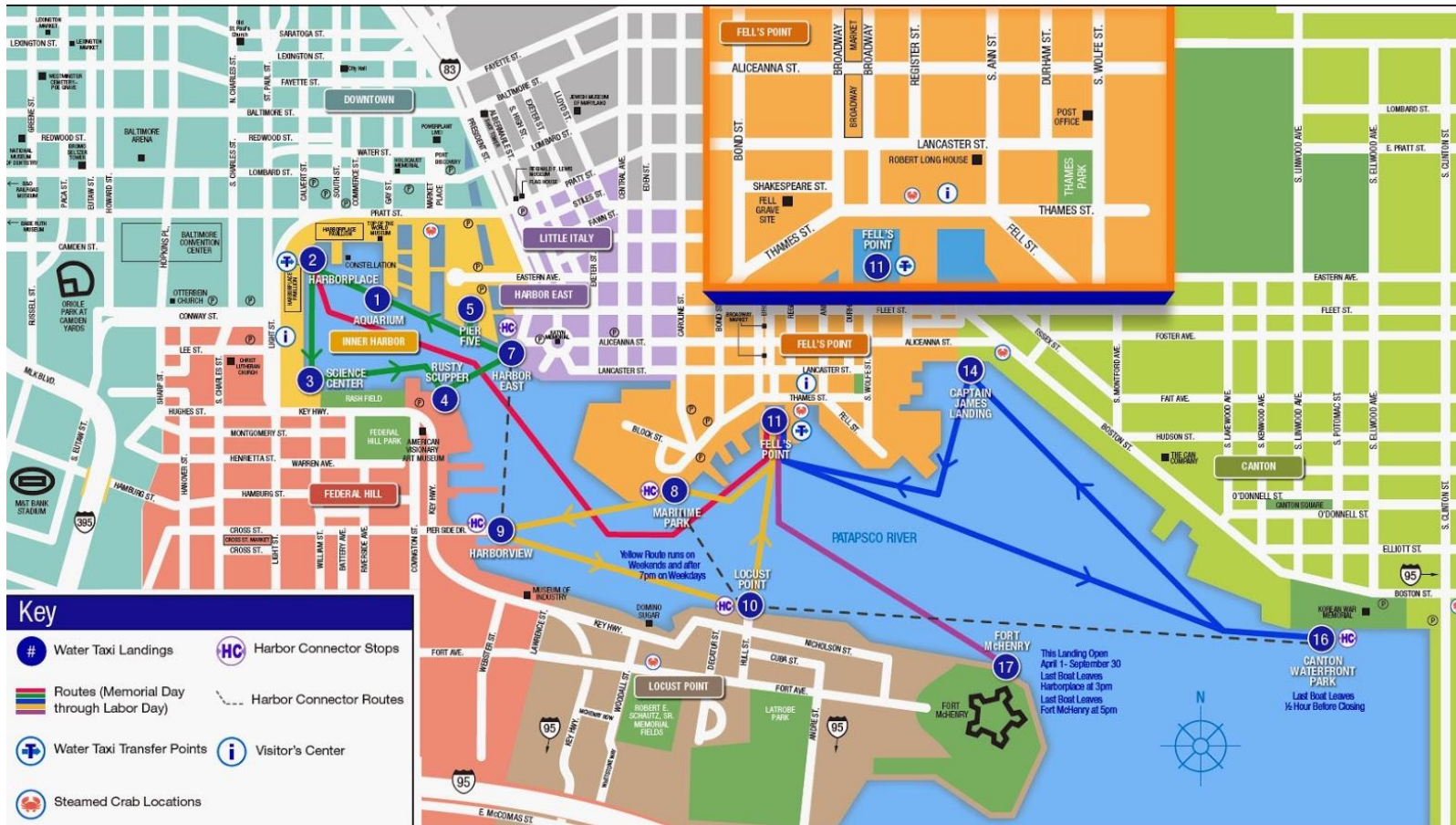
1. Fells Point stop on Water Taxi (just left of Broadway Pier)

5. Douglass-Myers (marked)
6. Sites connected with the Polish community (just north of the map on Ann Street and near the intersection of Broadway and Eastern Avenue, the east-west street above Fleet Street)
