#### **General Supplies**

- Paper (white and construction paper)
- Pencil and eraser
- Something to color with (crayons, markers, colored pencils)

### Supplies for Monday Activities – Flight School Journal & Edible 'Layers of the Atmosphere' Activity

- White paper (at least 5 sheets)
- Construction paper for cover (1-2 sheets)
- Large rubber band (large enough to fit over standard-size pages folded in half)
- Scissors
- Oreo cookies
