## **Basic Weaving on the Rigid Heddle Loom Weaving**

Recommending a 24" loom to be able to use later for other projects. However, all other sizes would also work.

#### **Loom should include:**

- At least 7.5 dent reed
- 2 shuttles
- Warping peg
- Clamps
- Double-ended threading hook

**Loom needs to be assembled and ready to work before the class!**

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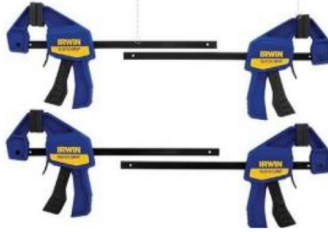
