Color Theory for Embroidery Artists

Supplies:

- Multipack of 4-inch bamboo embroidery hoops
- 1/2 yard of light-colored fabric suitable for embroidery such as medium-weave linen (Repurposed table linens work great!)
- Embroidery floss pack with at least 50 colors and a variety of blacks, whites and grays (DMC embroidery is better quality, but cheaper sets are available on Amazon and elsewhere)
- DMC 1765-1/5 Embroidery Hand Needles, 12-Pack, Size 1-5
- Washable fabric pen
- Embroidery scissors
- Felt or flannel (for backing if you wish to finish in the hoop)
- Sketchbook +colored pencils and/or variety of found colors in paper for collage
- Glue stick
