- 1 small bottle white gesso
- 2-3 cigar or other type of wood boxes
- Assortment of favorite colors of inexpensive acrylic paint (tube, fluid or jar ok)
- 3-5 sizes of inexpensive flat (1" or larger) and round acrylic brushes
- Any favorite collage papers and materials such as sheet music, book pages, newspapers, fabric
