Supplies needed:

- Small bottle of Liquitex or Golden Brand Gloss Medium & Varnish or Matte Medium
- Assortment of 6-8 colors of acrylic paint, including black and white (inexpensive craft paints are fine)
- 2-3 inexpensive paintbrushes -- 1"– 2" size, flat and round (assorted craft brush packs are a good option)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Exacto knife or utility knife
- Roll of clear packing tape
- 2-3 pieces of cardboard or old file folders
- Magazines, newspapers and other interesting found papers such as old books, sheet music, gift tissue, wrapping paper, etc.

OPTIONAL: Inks, stamps, stencils, found objects such as buttons, hardware
