

Chanticleer

- Opened in 1993 as a pleasure garden
- 35-acre garden/50-acre property
- Original owner Adolph Rosengarten – Pharmaceutical money
- Developed early by Chris Woods

Thailand

- Bangkok
- Chiang-mai
- Nong Nooch Tropical Garden and Resort (Pattaya)
 - Not just a garden – zoo, conference center, nursery, theater, European gardens, training school
 - Open to public in 1980
 - Started as a 520-acre family fruit orchard
 - Contains over 1,100 species of palms – half of those known world wide
 - Largest collection of cyciads

England

- Great Dixter (Northiam – 40mi SE of London)
 - Garden designed by Edwin Luytens in 1912
 - Six-acre garden
 - House dates back to 1450's
 - Christopher Lloyd and Fergus Garrett made the garden famous in the 1990's
- Beth Chatto Gardens (Colchester – 50mi NE of London)
 - Created in 1960
 - 7-acre garden
 - Gift shop, tea room, nursery,
 - Famous for gravel/scree garden

California

- The Huntington (San Marino)
 - 130-acre w. 16 themed gardens
 - 10-acre desert garden over 100-years old
 - Key living collections of orchids, cyciads, bonsai
- Valentine Garden (Private – Santa Barbara)
 - Designed by Isabella Green in 1982
 - 1-acre
- Lotusland (Santa Barbara)
 - 37-acre garden
 - Named one of 10 best gardens by Horticulture magazine
 - Estate evolved gardens and architecture from 1925
 - Gardens with Ganna Walska started in 1941 with Lockwood de Forest Jr.

Japan

- Daitokuji Temple (1319)
 - Large walled complex of Zen Buddhist temples
 - Two-dozen temples with many zen gardens
 - Zuiho-n Temple
 - Ryogen-in Temple
 - Daisen-in Temple
 - Ginkakuji Temple (Silver pavilion)
 - Zen temple dating 1490
 - Moss garden
 - Sand garden – cone named Moon Viewing Platform
 - Strolling garden

Morocco

- Anima sculpture garden (Marrakech)
 - 6-acre sculpture garden with café and gallery
 - Created by French artist Andre Heller
 - Works by Picasso, Haring, Calder and Rodin

Costa Rica

- Wilson Botanic Garden
- 30-acres (adjacent to 1 million-acre wet premountain tropical forest)
- Founder 1962 by Robert and Catherine Wilson
- 1973 research station
- Part of La Amistad Biosphere Reserve
- 700 palm collection
- Roberto Burle Marx assisted with initial plantings
