The facility just off the Suitland Parkway. Stop at the main gate, tell the officer that you are with a group that has an appointment at MSC (they will be expecting you and should have a list of the names). MSC is the big beige building to the left. There is parking in front of the building, and along the driveways, but if it is full, you can also park in front of the pink/salmon colored building to the right (that's the National Museum of the American Indian) and walk over. Parking is limited (we have construction blocking one of the lots right now) so if any folks can carpool, that will help. The Suitland metro stop is .7 miles away – it's not a pleasant walk, along a busy road with few pedestrians, but it's an option.
