Drawing in Museums

The materials for this class should be lightweight, portable, and simple. Drawing pads should be easily handheld. There will be opportunities for short exploratory studies and longer sessions for more finished drawings.

Recommended Materials:

- Comfortable shoes
- Portable stool (if standing is an issue)
- Drawing materials of choice. Recommended: drawing pencils (HB and 2B recommended); - Conte crayon (black, white, sanguine, etc); black and white charcoal pencils
- Medium size drawing pads. Recommended: 9x12 or 11x17 Strathmore 400 series drawing, pastel, or greyscale pad (or all three)
- Kneaded eraser

All pencils should be well sharpened.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:

- Wet drawing media (ink, watercolor, markers)
- Large drawing pads or drawing boards
- Oil pastels
- Paint of any kind
- Fixative spray
