ezōshiya	絵草紙屋	Edo period shop for prints and books
hanmoto	版元	Edo period publisher (lit. "origin of the block")
hanshita	版下	keyblock
hanshita-e	版下絵	block-ready drawing
hashira-e	柱絵	lit. "pillar print"
horishi	彫師	woodblock carver
ai	藍	indigo
kentō	見当	registration mark
kyōka	狂歌	style of comic verse with a 5-7-5-7-7 metre
Katsukawa Shunrō	勝川春朗	art name of Hokusai between 1779–1794
Katsukawa Shunshō	勝川春章	(1726–1793) One of Hokusai's teachers
Katsushika Hokusai	葛飾北斎	(1760–1849)
Katsushika Ōi	葛飾応為	(c. 1800–c. 1866) Hokusai's third daughter
Keisai Eisen	溪斎英泉	(1790–1848)
Konohanasakuya-hime	木花之佐久夜毬壳	female deity of Mt. Fuji
Okumura Masanobu	奥村政信	(1686–1764)
oshiokuri	おしおくり	high-speed delivery boat
Shiba Kōkan	司馬江漢	(1747–1818)
shita-e	下絵	preparatory drawing
sumi	墨	black carbon ink
surimono	摺物	privately produced and distributed print
surishi	摺師・刷師	woodblock printer
Suzuki Harunobu	鈴木春信	(c. 1725–1770)
