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### **A special note to you:**

It is the goal of this class to use recycled materials and art supplies you may already own. Do not feel like you need to go out and buy a lot of materials.

### **Found Materials to Recycle**

- Cardboard boxes – corrugated and tag board like cereal boxes
- Used envelopes
- Used stamps
- Patterned packaging (I found some inside tea boxes)
- Magazines
- Old photos
- Newspaper
- Old newsletters
- Any paper
- Ribbons, fabric scraps
- Old books

### **Things you need**

- Pencil and eraser
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Modge Podge (Or White glue and optional sealer like Matt or Gloss Medium)
- Paint – could be watercolor, or acrylic, or gouache (white plus any colors); If you don't own any watercolors and don't want to invest in a lot you could use a children's Prang watercolor set. If you want to try Crayola watercolors, you can but they are more like dyes and thinner than the Prang set. Prang is a little bit more money, but it will last a long time.
- A few sheets of white or light-colored paper (art paper or sketchbook or copy paper)
