SUPPLY LIST

Transparent Watercolors - Recommended Daniel Smith, Professional grade - 5 ml or equivalent

- Lemon yellow (cool)
- Cadmium Yellow (warm)
- Ultramarine Blue or French Ultramarine Blue (warm)
- Cerulean Blue (cool)
- Alizarin Crimson Red (cool)
- Cadmium Red (warm)
- Sap Green
- Quinacridone Gold
- Permanent Brown or Burnt Umber
- Pyroll Orange
- Burnt Sienna

General Brush: Silver Brush Black Velvet Brush - Round, Size 8

Pentel Water medium brushes (others if you have them)

Masking fluid (<u>https://www.dickblick.com/products/schmincke-aqua-masking-fluids/</u>) or something similar. It is best to have it be a colored masking fluid.

Pencils: HB, 2H, 2B

Watercolor Paper: your choice on size. I would recommend either Arches water color paper (140lb or 300lb) or fabriano artistico paper(140lb or 300lb) **HOT** press. Buy a large sheet of paper (<u>https://www.dickblick.com/items/arches-natural-white-watercolor-paper-22-x-30-hot-press-single-sheet/</u>) and cut to custom size. Or have at least an 11x17 sheet of watercolor paper.

Porcelain palette(s): 3 different options depending on your needs.
