Provided by the Student:

For the Embroidery

- One 5x5" square of medium weave linen fabric (light colors recommended, no gaps showing in the weave)
- A 3-4" diameter embroidery hoop
- Sharp Scissors
- Magnifying aids (reading glasses or craft visors) as needed.
- A 4x4" piece of cardboard - cereal or pasta box weight (thinner than a shipping box)

For the Necklace

- Beads: Please bring enough beads to string a necklace of your preferred length (20in. max.) Smaller sized beads (2-4mm) of any material are recommended. The image below will give you a sense of the colors used in the embroidery in case you'd like to match your beads to those. A Google search will bring up bead shops in the DMV, trusted online sources include:
