### **SUPPLY LIST**

#### Tools

- Scissors large and small
- Rotary cutter set cutter, mat, ruler(s)
- Iron & ironing board with pressing cloth
- Straight pins
- Sewing machine
- Hand sewing needles 8 betweens or your preferred assortment
- Seam ripper
- Thimble
- Marking tools pencils; heat sensitive or washable markers

## Materials for Warm-up exercise for Day 1:

- Ziplock bag of small fabric scraps
- A manila file folder
- Glue stick
- Project Materials for a wallhanging (15 x 40" or TBD)
- 1.5 yds backing fabric
- Small batting (crib or craft size): Quilters Dream Cotton or Dream Green
- 1/2 yard fabric you LOVE
- A pool of assorted improv fabrics of 2 (plus) yards in 1/4 to 1/2 yard pieces
- Include light & dark values-you may add to this as needed

# Project Materials for a throw quilt 60 x 60"

- 3 yds backing fabric
- Batting throw size (or larger)- Quilters Dream Cotton
- 1 yard fabric you LOVE
- A pool of assorted improv fabrics of 3.5 (plus) yards in 1/4 to 1/2 yard pieces.
- Include light & dark values-you may add to this as needed
