SUPPLY LIST

Fabric scissors

- Assorted hand needles - betweens and embroidery
- FABRICS - samples you may want to use for discussion. We won't cut these up.
- FABRICS - Small pieces for collage in a range of values and colors
- FABRICS - sample swatch 12" square for trying threads
- THREADS - assortment of your favorite sewing, quilting, embroidery and perle cotton, if you have them
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Glue stick - repositionable or fabric
- Notebook & pen/.5 mm pencil
- 12" ruler
- Graph paper - 8.5 x 11" size, at least 6 sheets
- Rotary cutter (size 45 or 60)
- Acrylic ruler – 18"

Please bring a selection of 3-4 fabrics of different types to add to the shared stash pile. 1/2 yard pieces or less will be fine.

We will create an inspiration reminder by embellishing a blank tote bag, provided.

You may bring your own machine if you are familiar with it or sew by hand.

PROVIDED SHARED MATERIALS

- * Rotary cutting mat, medium or large
- * Muslin pressing cloth - fat quarter size is perfect
- * Iron and ironing board
- * Mail order catalog, i.e., Smithsonian Associates brochure
