SUPPLY LIST

Marking tools for light and dark fabrics (fabric markers or colored pencils & sharpener)

- **** Sewing machine, including cords and pedals
- Fabric scissors
- Thread clipping scissors
- Rotary cutter (size 45 or 60)
- Acrylic rulers – 18” or 22” long and 12” square
- Straight pins
- Thread - High quality!
- 2 yards Fusible tricot knit interfacing (Easi-knit, Fusi-knit)
- T-shirt to be incorporated into your project (May use both sides)
- Backing fabric (if not using both front & back of the t-shirt)
- 14” pillow form
- Trash bag for your rags

PROVIDED SHARED MATERIALS

- * Rotary cutting mat, medium or large
- * Muslin pressing cloth - fat quarter size is perfect
- * Iron and ironing board

For optional design exercise at end of class

- Mail order catalog, i.e., Smithsonian Associates brochure
- Scissors for cutting paper
- Glue stick - repositionable preferably OR Scotch yape
- Notebook & pen
- .5 mm pencil
- 12” ruler
- Graph paper - 10 squares/inch, but any size will do (need 3 sheets)
- Calculator
