### Tasting Note

Light straw in color. On the nose, lemon zest, hay, roasted nuts, honeysuckle, as well as a hint of ginger. Light, maybe light to medium-bodied, rather austere with subtle notes of lime, unripe pear, a hint of yellow plum, saline, minerals, with medium acidity, as well as a touch of bitter walnuts, mild spices and grapefruit pith on the moderately long finish.

# CHÂTEAU RECOUGNE



## Bordeaux Supérieur 2020

Bordeaux, France

### ESTATE

Château Recogne has produced wine for more than 400 years, and has been recognized for nearly as long for producing outstanding wine - its name is said to have come from King Henri IV in the early 17th century, in "recognition" of the quality of its wine. The Milhade family purchased the estate in the early 1950s, and Recogne has become their flagship estate, producing quintessential pure Bordeaux each vintage – classic "claret" in the best sense of the word. Robert M. Parker Jr. called Chateau Recogne "...the best Bordeaux Supérieur money can buy."

### WINE

Today the wines are made by one of the young stars of the right bank, Marc Milhade - the fourth generation of his family to make wine at Recogne. Marc's philosophy and energy are directed primarily towards more work in the vineyard, and less intervention in the cellar.

### VINEYARD

*Soils:* Merlot is best suited to the gravelly clay terroir and is the majority planting here, comprising about 80% of the vineyard, complemented by equal parts of both Cabernets. Several vineyard parcels are over 50 years in age and much of the vineyard is planted at a high vine-density, contributing to the richness of the wine. The Milhades employ environmentally friendly viticultural techniques, and the vineyard is currently being converted to organic farming

### WINEMAKING

*Grape Varieties:* 78% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon

*Fermentation:* Selection is performed in the vineyard through green-harvesting, and the grapes are mostly destemmed, with 10-15% remaining as whole cluster for added structure. Fermentation takes place in traditional cement vats followed by 15 months aging in large vessels (no oak barrel) before bottling with minimal filtration.

*Alcohol:* 14.5%

### VINTAGE

A rainy winter followed cool spring weather and inconsistent flowering, but the summer weather was dry and warm with even temperatures through harvest. A little August rain helped the vines mature and kept acidities fresh. Bordeaux's Right Bank did exceptionally well, and Merlot and Cabernet Franc were particularly successful. The wines are rich, full, and savory, with ripe acidity and round, sweet tannins – an excellent vintage for the cellar, which nonetheless can be enjoyed young for its exuberant fruit.

### TASTING NOTES

A nose of red fruits, a deep and powerful structure, silky tannins: an elegant, complex and rich wine. These values give this wine an excellent aptitude for ageing.

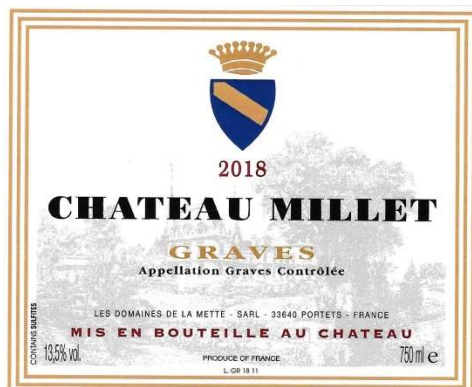

# CHÂTEAU MILLET

## GRAVES ROUGE



Château Millet is the crown jewel of the Domaines de La Mette, a collection of chateaux comprised of 62 hectares of vines in Graves and 20 hectares in Bordeaux Supérieur appellations. Ch. Millet is located 20 kms from Bordeaux in the village of Portets. The impressive chateau was re-built in the late 19th Century on the foundations of a Medieval castle. Today, the chateau and vineyards are in the loving care of Thierry de La Mette and Jean-Batiste Solorzano, who manages the day-to-day operations of Domaines de La Mette. Chateau Millet's 18.8 hectares of vines are planted on the gravelly soil of a clay and limestone plateau overlooking

the Garonne River. 1 hectare of vines facing south on ideal limestone soil is planted to white grape varieties, Sauvignon Blanc, Sauvignon Gris and Semillon. The southern exposure ensures an excellent maturity for these delicate grapes, giving them the signature style and taste that has made Graves wines famous. Chateau Millet Graves Blanc "Cuvée Henri" is named in homage to Thierry's late father, Henri de La Mette. The rest of the vineyard is planted to Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot and Carménère that produce a red wine that is at once elegant yet flavorful, the hallmark of Graves wines. Bright fruit, floral aromas and suppleness are the hallmarks of de La Mette wines, all invitations to the pleasures of the connoisseur's palate.

**Vinification and élevage:** Vinification in stainless steel; 2 to 3-week cuvaision, 9 to 12 months élevage in barrique, 25% new oak. Everything is done to make a generous, supple, elegantly balanced wine.

**Tasting notes:** Aromas of ripe dark fruits with a subtle hint of oak lead to a wine that is round and supple on the palate. Its layers of lush fruit combine with its ripe tannins to make this harmonious wine a joy to be enjoyed with beef and lamb dishes and flavorful cheeses. Classic Graves elegance!

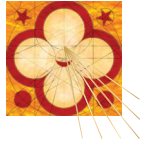

# LASSÈGUE®

SAINT-ÉMILION GRAND CRU

## CHÂTEAU LASSÈGUE

Ornate sundials adorn the façade of Château Lassègue, a beautiful 18th century Château. This symbol of perfect sun exposure is the inspiration for our logo and represents the message of our wines. Old vines grow on the south/southwest hills which are the prolongation of the Côte de Saint-Émilion, and whose soils of clay and limestone add exquisite minerality to their fruit. Rich, aromatic Cabernet Franc married to the dense concentration of old vine Merlot and seasoned with a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon results in a wine that is at once powerful and elegant.

## 2019 VINTAGE NOTES

A mild winter led to an early budbreak, followed by a wet spring leading into a consistent flowering in early June despite a few rain showers. The vines flourished throughout the hot and dry summer thanks to the water reserves absorbed by our clay and limestone terroir. While several summer rains refreshed the vines, the overall dry conditions led to a relatively drawn-out veraison. Warm and mild weather in early September was interspersed with several rain showers which refined the end of ripening. Harvest took place in excellent conditions between September 24th and October 9th.

## TASTING NOTES

The 2019 vintage of Lassègue is characterized by its freshness and purity. The wine shows a beautiful ruby color in the glass, limpid and brilliant. The nose is aromatic and precise, with red fruit that wafts from the glass at first aeration, followed by subtle notes of rose petal and licorice. The palate displays remarkable freshness, elegance and finesse. The attack is dense with a core of ripe red fruit, and a rich and precise mid-palate leading to a prolonged finish carried by seamlessly integrated silky tannins. The power, balance and minerality of this vintage reflect the complexity of the clay and limestone soils of the Côte de Saint-Émilion. A great vintage that will reach its peak in 15-20 years.
