Donald Grady Shomette served on the staff of the Library of Congress and as director of Nautical Archaeological Associates for over two decades. As a historian, Shomette has served as a cultural resources management consultant. As a marine archaeologist he has worked in the U.S., Canada, and Western Europe under the sponsorship of such institutions as the National Geographic Society, the National Park Service, the U.S. Navy, and various educational foundations and museums. Shomette is the author of twenty books, plus many scientific and popular articles and has appeared in documentaries on the History Channel, the Discovery Channel, the National Geographic Channel, among others. For more than a decade he served as a lecturer for the Smithsonian Journeys Program in the Great Lakes and along the entirety of the North American Atlantic Seaboard. Shomette was also honored with the Calvert Prize, the highest award in Maryland for historic preservation. He is a resident of Calvert County, MD.
