While there are many excellent studies on the topic of Leonese-Castilian infantas, not many of them are available in English. Bernard F. Reilly's books remain the best English-language overview of the reigns of many of the monarchs covered in this talk, with the addition of Therese Martin's important study of Queen Urraca. Lucy Pick's *Her Father's Daughter* is a groundbreaking reconsideration of early medieval infantas.
