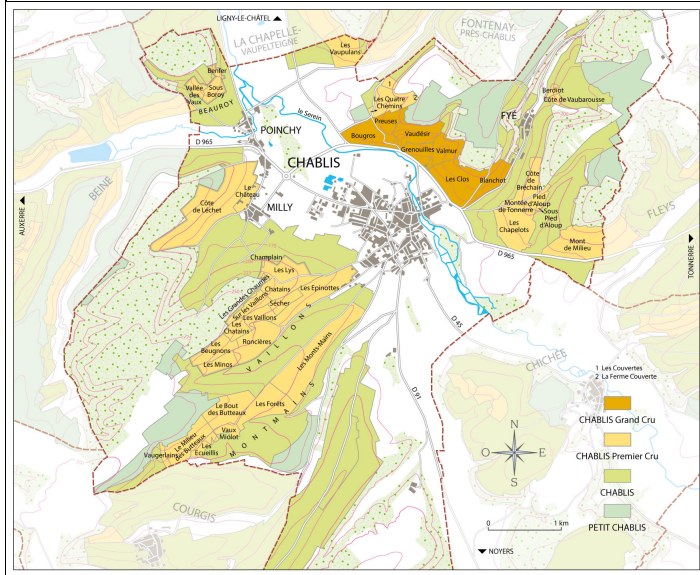
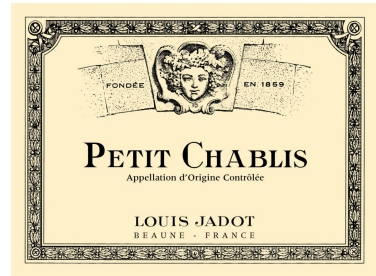

# PETIT CHABLIS

## Appellation Régionale

Chardonnay



### LOCATION

Chablis is in the northern part of Burgundy, half way between Dijon and Paris. The Petit Chablis area is produced in villages such as Chablis, Maligny, Beine ...

### VINEYARD INFORMATION

The continental climate (very cold in winter and hot in the summer with frosts in spring) and the marly limestone soils build the unique character of Chablis wines.

Almost the entire Chablis region is planted with Chardonnay.

The Petit Chablis category represents the first step in the Chablis range ; the area of production is 1 006 ha.

The Petit Chablis shows a nice straw yellow colour. It may have a slight green colour in some vintages.

It is always a straightforward wine with a very accessible minerality and never too mellow.

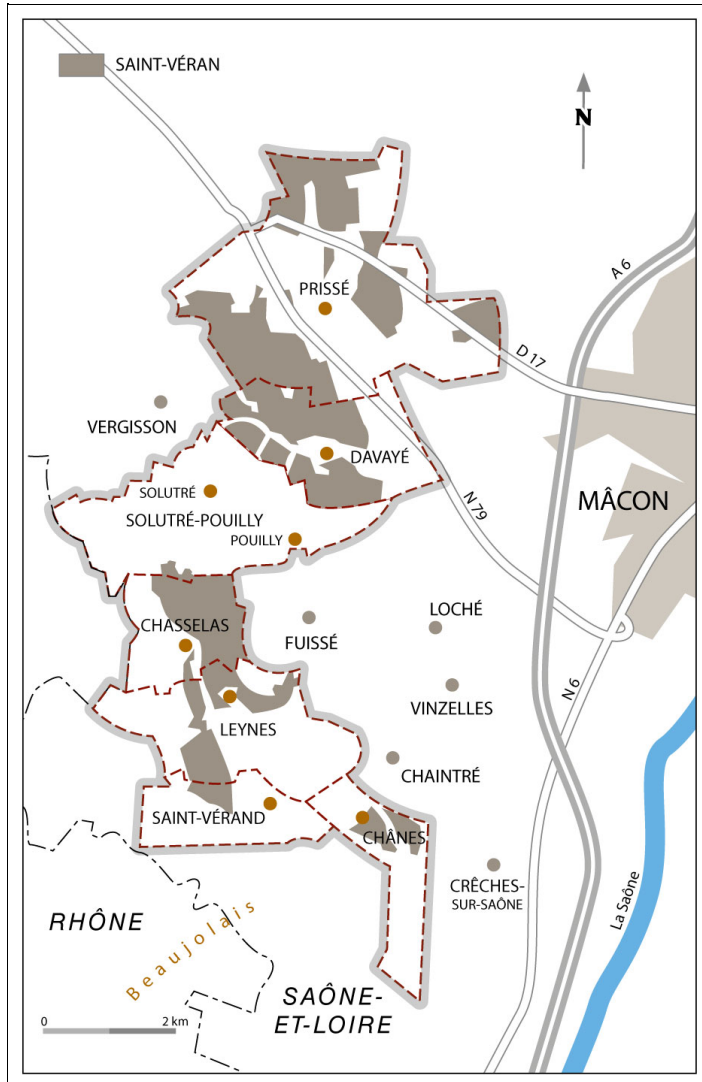
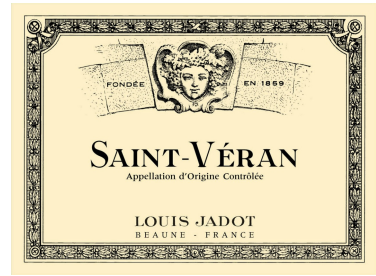

# SAINT-VÉRAND

## Appellation Village

Chardonnay



### LOCATION

Saint Vérand is a small commune in the Mâconnais region. To the north are the Pouilly-Fuissé, Pouilly-Loché and Pouilly-Vinzelles appellations.

### VINEYARD INFORMATION

Chardonnay is the only grape variety used for the white wines. The vineyards of Saint Vérand are planted predominantly in very stony, limestone soils.

### VINIFICATION AND MATURATION

Fermentation and aging take place in stainless steel tanks to preserve as much as possible the fruit and freshness.

## Bouzeron Village 2021

*France / Burgundy*

Bouzeron is a unique appellation in the Cote Chalonnaise dedicated to the production of white wines from the Aligote varietal. Jadot farms a large 12 acre parcel, on which the superior "aligote dorée" type is grown. This "golden" version allows for white wines with richness to counter the brisk acidity normally associated with Aligote.

### HARVEST NOTE

The 2021 vintage was memorable for the extreme challenges it posed to growers. The defining event was a hard freeze in April which lasted several days, and the subsequent dramatic reduction in harvest volumes. Added to this were cool and wet summer conditions which required constant vigilance. The delayed harvest eventually yielded tiny volumes of pristine grapes which express a vibrant and energetic purity.

### TASTING NOTE

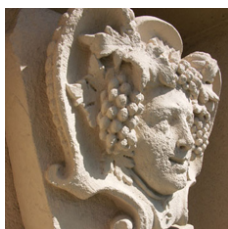
Grapefruit skin and wet stones predominate in the aromas, while the initial palate impression is taut acidity and energy. A generous and rounded structure soon takes hold, and the primary citrus flavors evolve to floral and earth notes over the moderately long finish.

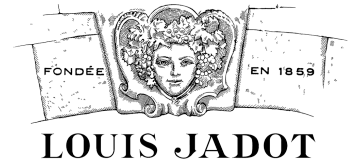

## Beaujolais-Villages 2022

*France / Burgundy*

Grapes are sourced from the finest vineyards within the Beaujolais-Villages appellation in northern Beaujolais. Louis Jadot practices the quality-driven “replis” method, whereby grapes of higher classifications from the 10 famed Beaujolais Cru villages are added to elevate the blend. The area’s granite and sandy subsoils contain a high percentage of manganese, which produces an especially deep and rich expression of Gamay. Grapes are handpicked in whole bunches and traditional Burgundian methods are used for vinification.

### HARVEST NOTE

The weather in Burgundy in mid-April was ideal, which allowed the vegetative cycle to start quickly, beginning 15 days ahead of the average start. At the time of flowering, the 2022 vintage looked like being one of the earliest in history. The hot and dry summer slowed the pace of the vines and the ripening of the grapes. Fortunately, the abundant rainfall in June and a few well-placed showers in mid-August gave the plants what they needed to transform the grape pulp into a generous juice. Harvest began in early September. The fruit had both good quality and quantity.

### TASTING NOTE

This crisp, fruit-forward, juicy wine has expressive aromas and flavors of ripe red berries, with nice weight in the mouth.

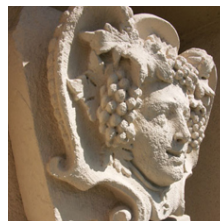

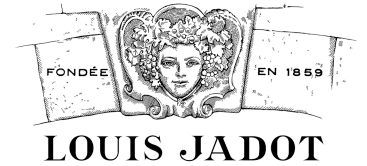

## Aurum Pinot Noir 2022

*France / Burgundy*

Aurum takes its name from the Latin word meaning gold, as it is grown among the rocky soils of the sunny southern part of Burgundy.

### HARVEST NOTE

The weather in Burgundy in mid-April was ideal, which allowed the vegetative cycle to start quickly, beginning 15 days ahead of the average start. At the time of flowering, the 2022 vintage looked like being one of the earliest in history. The hot and dry summer slowed the pace of the vines and the ripening of the grapes. Fortunately, the abundant rainfall in June and a few well-placed showers in mid-August gave the plants what they needed to transform the grape pulp into a generous juice. Harvest began in early September. The fruit had both good quality and quantity.

### TASTING NOTE

Ripe and expressive with intense aromas of cherries, red berries and smooth tannins on the finish.

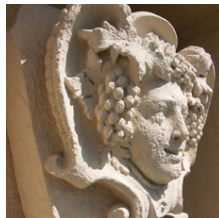

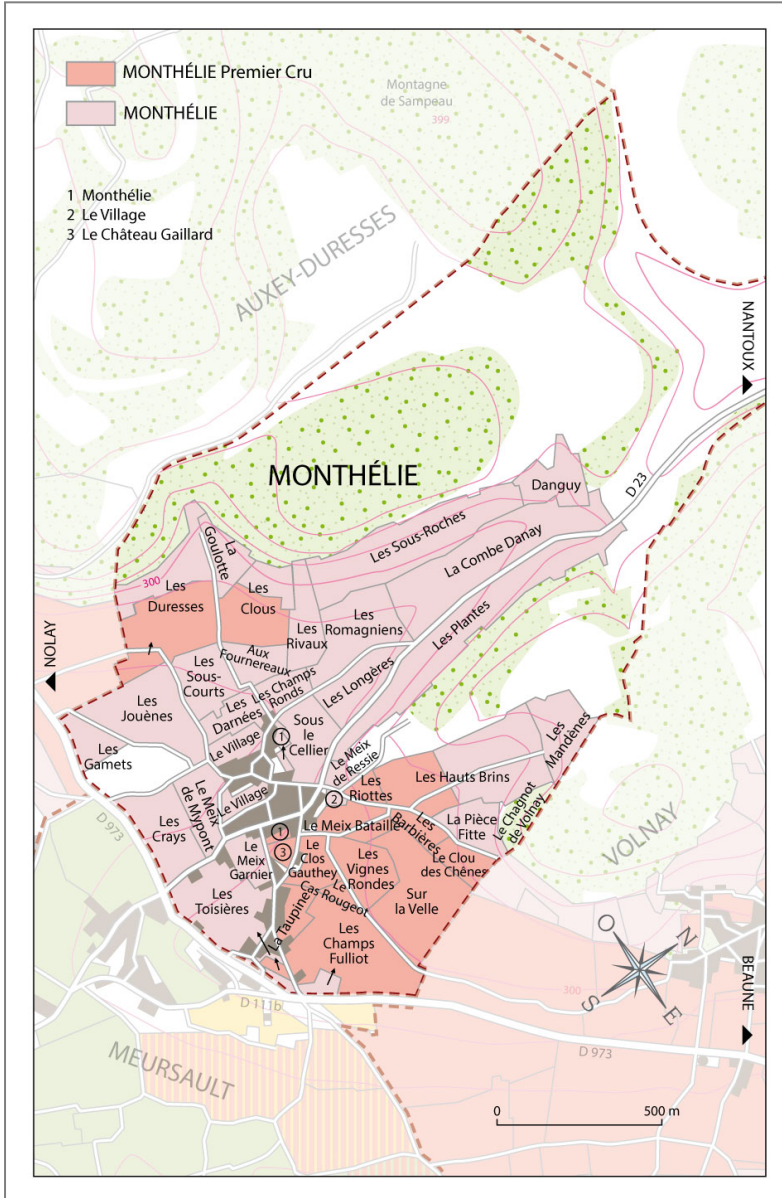
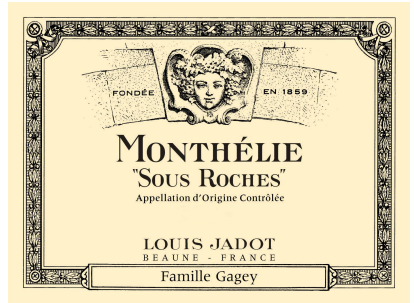

## Appellation Village

Pinot Noir



## SITUATION GÉOGRAPHIQUE

Monthélie is a small village located between Volnay and Meursault.

## CARACTÉRISTIQUES

This vineyard is 1.16 ha big and bought in 2010. It is very well oriented to the East with a rather high altitude and quite difficult to cultivate. Soil is made of clay and stony on the surface.

## VINIFICATION ET ÉLEVAGE

The grapes bear small little dark red berries. The bunches are destemmed; they macerate in open vats during 4 weeks helping this subtle terroir to reveal itself. After devatting, the wines are aged in oak barrels during 18 months.

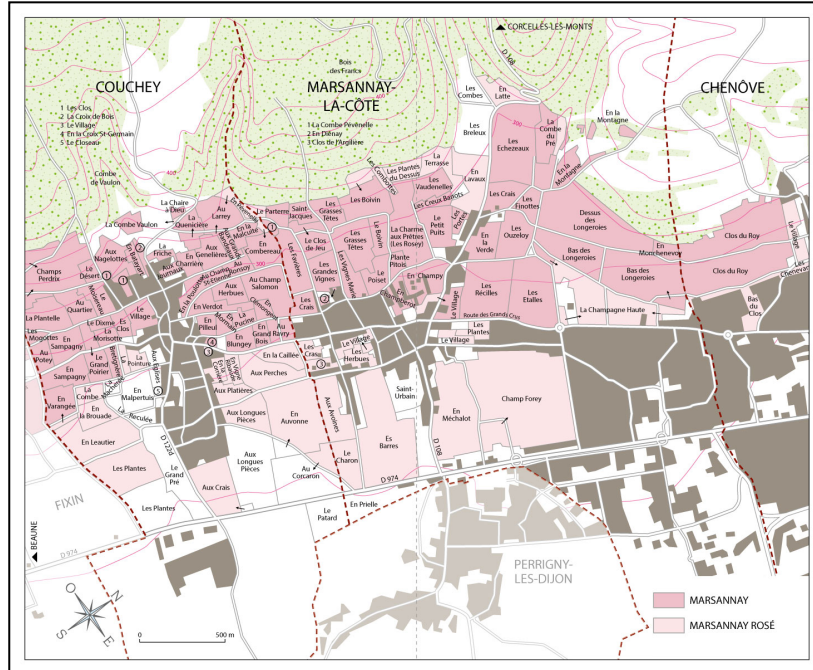

# MARSANNAY LONGEROIES

## Appellation Village

Pinot Noir



### SITUATION GÉOGRAPHIQUE

Marsannay belongs to the Côte de Nuits. It is located to the south of Dijon. This village produces red, white and rosé wines. The Longeroies vineyard is south-east oriented."

### CARACTÉRISTIQUES

Longeroies is one of the best crus in Marsannay. The vineyard is very old: more than 80 years old.

### VINIFICATION ET ÉLEVAGE

The grapes bear small little dark red berries. The bunches are destemmed; they macerate in open vats during 4 weeks helping this subtle terroir to reveal itself. After devatting, the wines are aged in oak barrels during 18 months.
