SUPPLY LIST

- photos to stitch on, 8"x10" or larger. Color or black and white, vintage photos can be fun to embroider.
- photos should be printed onto matte (preferable) or lustre surface photo paper, a thicker weight is good. www.nationphotoslab.com is a good place to have photos printed via on-line.
- extra piece of heavyweight paper such as card stock to practice stitches
- thin awl or ice pick. (can also use a large size sewing needle)
- embroidery sewing needles such as these:

- embroidery thread in a variety of colors – available at craft or sewing stores.
- pencil
- eraser
- tracing paper (can also use vellum or parchment paper)
- ruler
- piece of corrugated cardboard a little larger than your photos.
- Tape – scotch or masking.
- colored pencils (optional)
