- 8"x10" (or larger if desired) gel plate (Gel Press or Gelli Arts brand – NOT Speedball)
- Assortment of acrylic paints, including black and white (tube or bottle—mid-range brands such as Liquitex Basics, Amsterdam, Sargent, DecoArt or Artist Loft are good)
- Pad of 8"x10" or 9"x12" 140 lb. watercolor paper
- Scissors
- Pencil
- 4" or 5" soft rubber brayer
- Any previous gel prints

OPTIONAL: Additional small gel plate, e.g. 6"x6" or 5"x7"

Provided by Instructor (\$10 materials fee per student)

- Additional papers for printing
- Additional paints, inks
