SUPPLY LIST

- Beginner watercolor set: no more than 12 colors (**should have at least two reds, two blues, and two yellows. tubes of paint preferred)
 - **Watercolors should include the following pigments:**
 - Cadmium Yellow
 - Citron Yellow
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Vermillion (or Cadmium Red)
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Titanium White
- One watercolor brush roughly size 18
- One watercolor brush roughly size 10
- One watercolor palette (larger than what comes with a travel watercolor set, we need SPACE to mix)
- Two small containers for water
- Paper towels
- Pad of watercolor paper, at least 12 sheets, at least 9x12" 140lb/300gsm
