Supplies

- Two or more markers/pens—fine and wider tip (Sharpies, Pentel, Faber-Castell, Ad Markers, etc.)
- 1-2 Charcoal, graphite pencils or sticks, conte crayons, or chalk
- 4- 6 Assorted sizes of inexpensive acrylic or watercolor paintbrushes, including both flat and round between $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1" or $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 2" chip brush
- Small bottle of black sumi ink or other black India ink
- Assortment of inexpensive acrylic paints
- Choice of paper—8"x10" or larger pad/book of any of the following:
 - --140 lb. watercolor paper
 - --98 lb. mixed media paper
 - --Bristol paper
 - --Stonhenge drawing paper
 - --Other heavier weight (90 lb) drawing paper
- Paper towels
- Scissors
- Assortment of household items such as an old credit or other plastic card, chopsticks, plastic forks, thread spools, bottle caps, etc.

OPTIONAL: Brayer, spray bottle for water; other types of paper such as rice paper, tracing paper, vellum; acrylic paint markers, oil pastels, acrylic inks
