- BRUSHES:
 - Sable or Synthetic blend #1, 4, 6 and 10 or12 Round pointed and 1" Flat, make sure that the round brushes form a good point and spring back to shape when wet
- PAINTS:
 - Tube paints. I recommend 'professional' or 'artist' grade paints only. Brands: (First choice)

 Artist etc.
- Suggested colors:

 - Permanent Rose
 - Burnt Sienna, Payne's Gray
 - Winsor Violet
 - o Veridian Green
 - o Burnt Umber
- PALETTE: With plenty of mixing area
- OTHER:
 - o Any spiral bound 9"X12" watercolor sketchbook for practice sketches etc.
 - Two containers for water
 - A small water spray bottle
 - Graphite Pencils HB
 - Soft white Eraser
