### ABOUT YARDEN

Yarden is the premier label and flagship brand of Golan Heights Winery. Each year, the finest grapes from the best vineyards are reserved for Yarden wines. "Yarden" is the Hebrew word for Jordan River, which bisects the Golan Heights from the Galilee. The label features a symbol of ancient Israel: an oil lamp decorated with mosaic tile.

### THE WINE

The 2022 Yarden Katzrin Chardonnay shows off enticing lemon and pear fruit notes, along with pleasing characters of tropical fruits, flowers, spice and a hint of brioche. This full-bodied Chardonnay is full-flavored yet bright and drinkable. Yarden Katzrin Chardonnay is produced exclusively from grapes grown in the northern Golan Heights in our best Chardonnay vineyards, which have been certified for sustainable winegrowing. The wine aged sur lie in new French oak barrels for nine months. Though enjoyable now, the 2022 Yarden Katzrin Chardonnay will develop in the bottle for several years and remain in great drinking shape for about eight years from harvest. The wine pairs wonderfully with hazelnut-crusted red-snapper, grilled free-range veal chops, or a festive cheese board.

### THE VINTAGE

The festive 2022 harvest marked our 40th vintage and first since 2019 not understrict coronavirus protocols. A rainy March ensured the start of spring growth with the desired full water profile in the Golan's beautiful volcanic soils. Though a historic heat wave hit at the end of August, our deep-rooted vineyards were largely unaffected. Our ever-increasing vine resilience and vineyard resolution, as shown by our growing number of vineyard blocks, has led to ever-increasing wine quality. The relatively short 11-week 2022 vintage delivered quality fruit and yields 4% above normal, making for yet another outstanding harvest in the Golan Height.

### ABOUT THE GALILEE APPELLATION

The Galilee (or Galil) is the northernmost — and generally considered the best — appellation in Israel. The highest quality growing area within the appellation is the Golan Heights (or simply the Golan), also the coldest region in Israel. The vineyards on this volcanic plateau rise from 1,300 feet to 3,900 feet above sea level and receive snowfall in the winter. Golan Heights Winery is located in the town of Katzrin in the central Golan.

# DABOUKI 2023 INSPIRE ART

The end of the day, feet up on the table.  
A glass of pink wine in your hand. That's it,  
you're all set.

## Wine Details

100% Dabouki, 2023, Old vines in Givat Nili from the Zichron Yaakov Region of Israel, Hand harvested in the early morning, On release to the market

## Wine production process

The Dabouki grapes arrived in the morning hours. The grapes were immediately chilled to 12° C and gently pressed to preserve the high quality of the fruit. After gentle pressing, the must was transferred to a chilled stainless-steel tank and clarified via flotation pump. This technique floats the sediments to the top of the tank via micro-bubbles of nitrogen. Once successful separation was achieved, the clear must was racked from the bottom of the tank to another stainless-steel tank in which the wine fermented. The fermentation was carried out at 14° C to produce and preserve aromatic expression and elegance. After the fermentation, the wine aged on its lees for approximately 6 months prior to bottling. In order to preserve natural acidity and crisp flavors, this wine did not undergo malo-lactic fermentation.

50% Shiraz from Elkosh and Safsufa Vineyards  
40% Grenache from Even Menachem Vineyard  
10% Carignan from Kfar Tabor Vineyard

Each plot was harvested and fermented and initially aged separately. After a year the wine was blended and further aged in concrete tanks and a large wooden cask (Foudre).

### TASTING NOTES

Alma Scarlet is a wine showing rich earthy characteristics of leather and liquorice with underlying floral notes and wild raspberries. The wine has good body with a rich silky finish.

### THE VINTAGE



**THE WINE**

The 2021 Yarden Petit Verdot features pleasing cherry, raspberry and plum fruit notes, along with nuances of flowers, spice and tobacco. This flavorful wine exhibits full body and a bit of tannic structure typical to the Petit Verdot variety. Though drinkable upon release, the 2021 Yarden Petit Verdot will continue developing in the bottle for a few years and stay in outstanding drinking shape for ten years and more from vintage. Give the wine a go with roasted rack of lamb, slow-cooked beef short ribs, or grilled portobello mushrooms.
