- size-8 needles
- worsted-weight yarn
- a yarn needle
- optional, a knitting project that needs attention

Prior to the workshop: knit the quick, simple piece below that we will discuss in class.

Work Sample

CO8St.

Work two rows of stockinette then on the next RS row randomly purl one stitch among knits Work even in stockinette until section measures 1 Intentionally drop a random stitch in the next row (stitch holder optional for dropped stitch)

Work 4 more rows even

Knit 4 rows even (garter stitch)

Work four rows stockinette

In next RS row, k2tog once, randomly and twist a stitch randomly

Work three more rows in stockinette

Techniques to practice in sample

CO8St.

Frogging

Work two rows of stockinette then on the next RS row randomly purl one stitch among knits

Drop Down

Work even in stockinette until section measures 1

Intentionally drop a random stitch in the next row

Work 4 more rows

Drop Garter Section

Knit 4 rows even

Tinking

Work four rows stockinette

In next RS row, k2tog once, randomly and twist a stitch randomly

Work three more rows in stockinette
