Tasting Kit Pick-Up Instructions

Thank you for registering for "Madeira, a Gift From an Island to the World," which will take place on Friday, November 14, 2025. Please read these instructions carefully (the pick-up location has changed).

You may pick up your tasting kit(s) on **Thursday, November 13, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** OR **Friday, November 14, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** The pick-up location is **Cowbell Seafood & Oyster** (look for the big blue ceiling) at Union Market, 1309 5th St NE, Washington, DC 20002. Metro: NoMa–Gallaudet U station on the Red Line.

Please note that that Union Market is a vibrant and bustling hot spot, and we recommend arriving by metro. If you wish to drive, there is a free parking lot between 5th and 6th Neal Place, NE—entrance on 6th. Additional backup parking garages can be found in the area. Please visit the restaurant to pick-up your kit(s) only during the recommended windows. Note: Thursday between **11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** is preferred.

Please be prepared with the following info:

- NEW: Your ticket purchase confirmation, either printed or readily available on your smart phone
- 2. Your first and last name (please make sure to use the name that was used to register)
- 3. Number of tasting kits in your order

A staff member will check ID and distribute your tasting kit(s).

Class notes:

• Chill all wines until 20 minutes before class begins. For side-by-side pairings, 2-4 glasses are recommended.

Glass bottle recycling: You may return your glass bottles to **Cowbell Seafood & Oyster** to be washed, sanitized, and reused. Please note that the restaurant can only receive used vials during pick-up windows for Smithsonian classes; the next pick-up dates will be **December 11 and 12.**
