SUPPLY LIST

- Planning notebook
- Basic sewing supplies
 - Scissors/shears for fabric
 - Rotary Cutter set - cutter, ruler, mat
 - Straight Pins
 - Seam Ripper
 - Hand Needles - between 9 & an assortment of Embroidery needles 7-1
 - Marking tools - pencils, and removable markers
 - High quality thread - cotton (Gutermann, Presencia)
 - Embroidery Floss
 - Batting (Quilter's Dream Brand is my preference)
 - **Fabric for your project - High quality quilting cotton**
 - 1-1/2 yard total background colors on the front
 - 1-1/2 yard backing fabric
 - Assortment of 1/4 yard pieces for flowers and stems
- OPTIONAL:
 - Sewing machine with manual, accessories and extra needles
 - Ironing Board and Iron
 - Design wall
