OIL PAINTING MATERIALS

PAINTS

- Cadmium yellow
- Cadmium orange
- Cadmium red
- Alizarin crimson
- *Dioxazine purple (or Violet)
- Cobalt blue
- Cerulean blue
- Phthalo green
- *Raw umber
- Mars black
- Titanium white

*Optional

BRUSHES

- Natural bristle brushes: #2 filbert, #4 filbert, #8 flat, #12 flat, #2 round.

Note: These brushes/sizes are suggestions only. Students are encouraged to experiment with various brushes.

CANVAS

- Stretched canvas or canvas board, recommended size 11 x 14".

PALETTE and MISC.

- Palette
- Palette knife
- Odorless mineral spirits
- Linseed oil
- "Silicoil" spring jar (for mineral spirits)
- Stretched canvas or canvas board, recommended size 11 x 14".
