- Pad of 9"x12" or 11"x14" Yupo paper (Blick, Cheap Joe's Art Stuff, Amazon)
- Set of alcohol inks in a variety of colors (Jaquard Pinata and Ranger/Tim Holtz brands available online and at Michael's and other art supply stores)
- Small assortment of inexpensive paint brushes in assorted sizes, flat and round
- One bottle of 91% rubbing alcohol (any drugstore brand)
- One bottle of alcohol ink Blending Solution (not absolutely necessary but recommended)
- Optional: stamps, stencils, collage materials
