SUPPLY LIST

Our class cost includes a sketchbook, no need to bring one.

YOU SUPPLY

- A jacket! We will be painting outside unless the weather does not co-operate
- An easy-to-carry version of your larger indoor palette. You can fill these small palettes with your own paints or use pre-filled palettes. I use these
 - Yarka 12 watercolor set (pre-filled with great colors, inexpensive) Cheapjoes.com
 - Daniel Smith pocket box (pre-filled with Daniel Smith colors, often includes an extra empty palette) Danielsmith.com
 - Arttoolkit.com: Empty slim aluminum box, empty magnetic pans for filling with your own colors
- A pencil, eraser, pen or Pigma marker size .05
- A paintbrush and water container and/or waterbrush
- A few paper towels
- A snack and a drink

That's all you need! The garden has places to sit, but feel free to bring your painting stool.
