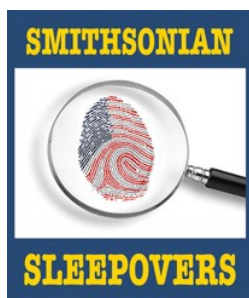
Museum Sleepovers for Kids: Energetic Volunteers and Interns Make them Fun!

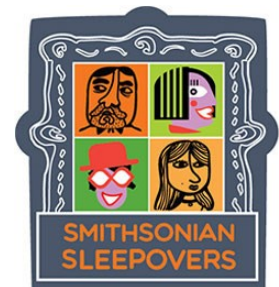
